What: Returning school technology devices/ school devices on loan for distance learning

As the School Year 20-21 comes to an end, students who have a school device(s) used for distance learning are required to return their device(s) with attachments.

Returned devices must be in similar to good condition when loaned out to you (student). Returned devices will be assessed if operable without damages. Normal wear and tear is expected and you will be notified if disparity is found on device(s). Any damages caused by mishandling of the device(s) will result in a financial obligation and will be the responsibility of the student assigned to the device(s).

Students participating in the Summer Learning Hub for credit recovery will be **allowed** to use their device for the duration of the Summer Learning Hub, **except** for **Hotspots**.
