With that in mind, we would like to kick off the new school year with a drive-through Schedule Pick Up Day on Wednesday, July 14, 2021 from 9:00 am - 12:00pm in the Kailua High School parking lot. (Please refer to the included checklist for your child's designated pick up time.) The schedule pick up packet will include the beginning of the school year information as well as student schedules. Fee payments (student fees, lunch deposits, and school bus payments) will also be accepted at this time.
