

**KAILUA HIGH SCHOOL
SCHOOL/CAFETERIA/MEAL LUNCH PROGRAM**

To improve accuracy in our School Food Services Program, we have installed the Etrition system. The technology requires students to set up an account against which food and beverage purchases are debited.

How do students apply for reduced priced/free meals? Students who received Free and Reduced Price Meals last year are automatically entered in the system and **will continue only for the first 30 days of this year.**

Everyone must reapply to continue to qualify for continued service. Applications will be in the front office or you may fill out the application online at [EZMealApp](#). Upon receipt of a completed application, the School Food Service Branch has 10 working days to make a decision whether your household qualifies for reduced/free meals or is denied the benefit.

What's the plan? Students will use the school's photo ID card with a barcode that can debit their account. Another student cannot use this card. Deposits are only accepted at the Bookkeeping office. Our cashiers will scan the student ID for purchases. A student may ask for their balance at the time of transaction or at the Bookkeeping office.

How do Freshmen/New Students get their ID cards? All freshmen and new students may take their ID pictures on Schedule Pickup Day (07/14/21) between the hours of 9:00am-12:00 noon. There is no charge for a student's 1st ID card.

What if you need to replace an ID card? All other students who need to replace an ID card should come to Rm. F-20 during the 1st week of school during lunch. Replacement cards will cost \$5.00, payable upon receipt of the new card. Students or parents may deposit money into their account at the Bookkeeping office before school and during lunch or online at [EZSchoolPay](#).

How much money should we deposit for our student? You may deposit \$1.00-\$100.00 into each student's account. Regardless of the amount deposited, the system will keep a running balance of the student's individual account.

What can be purchased with the ID card? Breakfast and Lunch, including additional food and beverages. To help you figure out how much money to send, here are the prices: *(Please note the prices below may be subject to change).*

Breakfast:	\$1.10	Lunch:	\$2.75
Reduced Breakfast:	\$0.30	Reduced Lunch:	\$0.40
2nd & Subsequent Breakfast:	\$2.40	2nd & Subsequent Lunch:	\$5.50
Milk:	\$0.60		

Breakfast will be from 7:45-8:15am and lunch is served on Monday-Tuesday-Thursday-Friday from 12:20-12:50pm and on Wednesday from 11:15-11:45am.

What if a Free or Reduced Meal student wants to purchase additional food? These students are entitled to 1 breakfast and 1 lunch per day. For additional food the student must have money in their account to purchase these items.

What if I forget or lose my card? We have a "Meal Card" for each student and can only be used for breakfast and lunch. **This is not a substitute ID.** The cashier will swipe the card for the meal and return the card to the file box for safekeeping.
