tion experience for students starting in eighth grade and continuing until healthcare higher education and career goals are met.

The Academy provides exploration into health fields and prepares students for the rigors of healthcare training programs through activities that focus on STEM, leadership, and communication.

The Academy also provides students advising and mentoring sessions. Students are selected to participate in five years of programming in sessions filled with activities and workshops to promote academic success, career development, and personal growth. One-on-one mentoring and hands on STEM learning are major components of the Academy.

The Hawaii/Pacific Basin Area Health Education Center is here to improve the health of the underserved through education.
